A Snapshot of what we've been able to create in the past 3 years

As a grassroots organization, we are grateful for the support of our sponsors and partners who have helped us accomplished so much.

01

Hand Delivered 6,200 pounds of donations

These much needed donations (clothing, shoes, school supplies, backpacks, etc) were hand delivered by our volunteers to our grateful community.

02

Provided 55,568+ meals for our community

These meals fed our 30+ kiddos and their families and other families throughout the community.

03

Created a Sewing Center

We bought our own land and a house that we use as our Sewing Center where we have extra land to build our Community Center.

04

Built 2,000+ gardens = 110,000 meals

In the last two years we've built and installed over 2000 gardens which have provided 110,000 meals for hundreds of families for years to come.

Provided health exams and vitamins

We have provided health exams for all of our 30+ kiddos



The Problems We Are Addressing In Guatemala

In Guatemala, the most impoverished communities face significant challenges that hinder their ability to break the cycle of poverty. These challenges include:

a

Lack of Income

Many families struggle to meet basic needs due to insufficient income opportunities, which perpetuates the cycle of poverty. We support our families with business classes and micro-funding.

b

Guatemala is the 4th most Malnourished Country in the World

With a significant portion of the population living below the poverty line, this often means that families do not have the financial means to provide their children with adequate food, leading to malnutrition.

c

Lack of Educational Opportunities

Receiving an education can change the trajectory of an individual's life and learning English is a powerful tool for improving educational and economic opportunities.
